

TRANSPARENCY & CONSENT

-Thinking Around it

☐ For consent to be informative and specific, it requires a statement or a clear affirmative act

- the data subject must be clear
- data subject must be informed of how will it be used
- purpose of processing operations
- data subject is informed of the right to withdraw
- the right to withdraw must be as easy as giving data
- data explained and clarified if used for automated decision making if relevant
- detail data transfer risks that are safeguarded

☐ RISKS

- Persons should be made aware of risks, rules, safeguards and rights
- Personal data should be processed only if the purpose of processing could not reasonably be fulfilled by other means
